Password Protection

For the best results, opt for passwords that feature capitalized and lowercase letters along with randomly interspersed numbers and special characters.

Have trouble remembering passwords that are too obscure? Consider creating a password in which each letter represents a word in a phrase. Using mnemonics is a great way to avoid confusing passwords if you have a wide range of accounts to protect.
